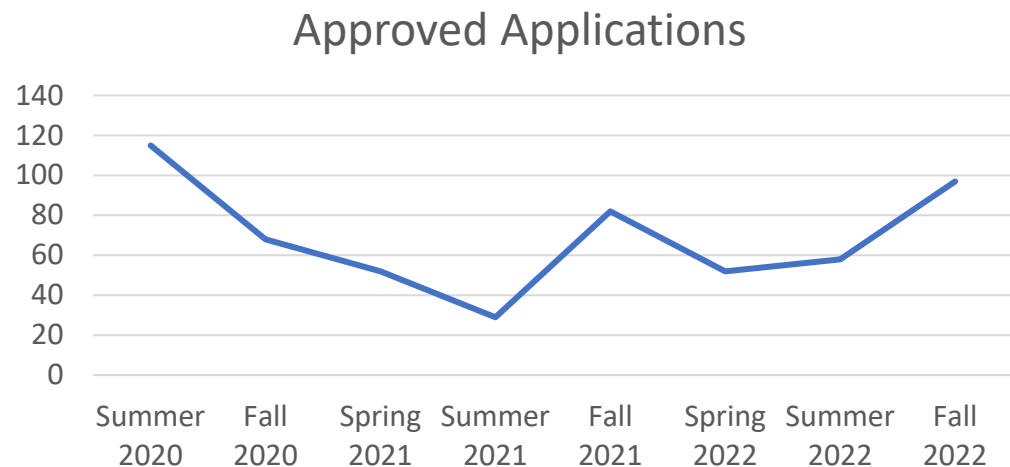

Herzing's Crisis Support Grant

- Started in the Summer of 2020 during the early stages of the COVID-19 pandemic
- Students are identified by Financial Aid and Student Services team members and sent an application to apply
- Since onset and through calendar year 2022, 553 unique students have received this funding



Successes

- 2/3 of recipients have achieved positive intermediate and long-term results
- Program benefits outweigh costs – ROI in terms of finance over 2,000%*
- Cross-departmental approach to addressing students in Crisis

Challenges

- Ensuring students are using all available resources
 - Ex: Federal Financial Aid
- How to measure program success
- Time constraints in processing
