



## Herzing's Crisis Support Grant

- Started in the Summer of 2020 during the early stages of the COVID-19 pandemic
- Students are identified by <u>Financial Aid</u> and <u>Student Services</u> team members and sent an application to apply
- Since onset and through calendar year 2022, <u>553 unique</u> students have received this funding





#### Successes

- 2/3 of recipients have achieved positive intermediate and longterm results
- Program benefits outweigh costs ROI in terms of finance over 2,000%\*
- Cross-departmental approach to addressing students in Crisis



## Challenges

- Ensuring students are using all available resources
  - Ex: Federal Financial Aid
- How to measure program success
- Time constraints in processing
